🕒 All times are approximate. Streetcars run less often early mornings and evenings.

The **St. Charles** line runs from 4:15 to 3 am, every 8 minutes.

The **Canal** line to **Cemeteries** runs from 5 to 3 am, every 10-20 minutes.

The **Canal** line to **Museum** runs from 7 to 1:15 am, every 40-45 minutes.

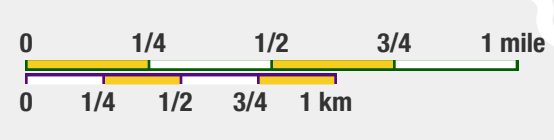
The **Riverfront** line runs from 7:15 am to 10:30 pm weekdays, every 18-19 minutes, and from 8:30 am to 10:30 pm weekends, every 9-18 minutes.

This map includes both existing and future streetcar lines.

The **St. Charles, Canal and Riverfront** lines already exist.

The **Loyola/UPT** (purple line, south of Canal) and **French Quarter** (north of Canal) extensions will open in 2012 and 2013. The Elysian Fields Avenue spur of the French Quarter extension is shown as part of the Riverfront Line.

The **Convention Center** extension would be part of the Riverfront line, which would then operate northbound only between Thalia and Canal. Its opening date is uncertain.
